## NEW BOOK BY MASTER STORYTELLER AND NON-FICTION AUTHOR RON FELBER RECOUNTS CHILLING EPISODE OF POSSIBLE ALIEN ABDUCTION

Ron Felber is well-known as the author of both novels and non-fiction books that explore unusual, yet compelling topics. He is often drawn to unconventional subjects, whether it's a Mafia doctor in *II Doctore* or human trafficking in *The Kafka Society*. It's no wonder then that Felber was intrigued by the story of Elise and Tom Gifford, who claimed to have been abducted by extraterrestrials during a desert camping trip that turned their lives upside down. Felber recounts their chilling experiences in the **MOJAVE INCIDENT** (Barricade Books; September 2015), a powerful book that takes readers on a riveting journey they will not soon forget.

As Felber explains, when Elise and Tom Gifford headed out to the Mojave Desert, they anticipated a quiet camping trip – a short break from family, friends, and the everyday routine that filled their lives. But when they were kidnapped by what they believed to be a swarm of alien beings, the shock and pain of the experience changed their lives forever. "They wanted everything we had . . . our minds, bodies, our souls," Elise Gifford told Felber. "I thought we were going to die, or had already died and we were being tortured in Hell."

The Giffords' nightmare began when they spied nine glowing objects over a desolate stretch of the Mojave Desert. As they tried to convince themselves that they were looking at weather balloons or military exercises, the nighttime sky suddenly filled with hundreds of shiny objects flashing signals to one another. Surrounded and trapped in their camper, the couple says they were dragged through psychological torture, compelled to relive their most painful and intimate memories.

Felber goes on to describes how the Giffords survived their ordeal, only to discover that it wasn't really over. For months afterward, they felt and saw the presence of the aliens in their California home, and feared for their children's safety. With vivid description, Felber puts the reader directly into the shoes of the increasingly confused and terrified couple in the **MOJAVE INCIDENT**.

As part of the book, Felber explains how he came to meet the Giffords, and how he connected them with the National Center for Trauma. He reveals the conclusions drawn by the Center's renowned director, and also details how the couple ultimately underwent a retrogressive hypnotic technique often used with trauma victims – and what this hypnosis revealed.

"I am personally convinced that an extremely rare event in human development happened," declares Felber. "Tom and Elise Gifford are stable, credible individuals. Their story is a crack in the wall that offers the opportunity to see beyond this reality into another so startlingly different that it will change the way you view man's place in the world forever."

Simultaneously terrifying and illuminating, **THE MOJAVE INCIDENT** is a must-read for anyone interested in the paranormal, and in rethinking the parameters of our world and our existence.
